

# 26th Australian Turfgrass Conference Lucky Prize Draw

## Terms and Conditions

The following terms and conditions apply for the 26th Australian Turfgrass Conference Lucky Prize Draw (the "Competition"), and by submitting an entry into this Competition, entrants warrant that they have read, understand and agree to be bound by them. These terms and conditions can be downloaded from the AGCSA website.

### 1. PROMOTER

The Promoter is the Australian Golf Course Superintendents Association (ABN 96 053 205 888) of Suite 1, Monash Corporate Centre, 752 Blackburn Road, Clayton, VIC 3168 (the "Promoter").

### 2. DURATION

The Competition will take place from 22 June 2010 to 24 June 2010 during the 26th Australian Turfgrass Conference Trade Exhibition to be held at the Gold Coast Convention and Exhibition Centre, Broadbeach, Queensland.

### 3. ELIGIBILITY

**3.1.** Entry to the Competition is open to all who are professionally employed in the turf management industry over the age of 16 and who attend the 26th Australian Turfgrass Conference Trade Exhibition. This includes those persons employed who manage, produce, or maintain turf surfaces (eg: golf courses, bowling greens, cricket ovals, sportsfields, parks and gardens, racetracks, school facilities, turf producers).

**3.2.** The following are not eligible (please note that final determination of eligibility will be at the discretion of the Promoter)

- Employees of any turf industry allied trade company and their families;
- Employees of the Promoter and their families;
- Family members of those employed in the turf management industry;
- Staff employed by golf clubs, sports clubs, councils, education providers and the like who are not involved in the provision or maintenance of turf surfaces (eg: administration, catering, cleaners, building contractors).

**3.3.** All winners may be asked to provide proof of their employment within the turf management industry before being awarded any prize (**refer to 7. Prize Collection**)

### 4. METHOD OF ENTRY

Entry into the Competition is free. To enter the Competition, a participant must obtain eight category stamps from companies exhibiting at the 26th Australian Turfgrass Conference Trade Exhibition as indicated by the categories on the Lucky Prize Draw entry card. Once they have obtained these their card must be placed in a barrel located at the Australian Golf Course Superintendents Association stand at the trade exhibition no later than 3.30pm Thursday 24 June. Only one entry is allowed per person. Incomplete or incomprehensible entries (whichever is applicable) will not be eligible and will be disqualified.

### 5. PRIZES

All prize values are in Australian dollars and are correct at the time of printing.

## **6. AWARDING OF PRIZES and NOTIFICATION**

**6.1.** Three entries will be drawn at random from the barrel located at the AGCSA stand located within the 26th Australian Turfgrass Conference Trade Exhibition at the Gold Coast Convention and Exhibition Centre at 4pm, 24 June 2010. Once these entries are verified by AGCSA staff as being complete they will be deemed as the winners.

**6.2.** Prize winners will be announced at the 26th Australian Turfgrass Conference Trade Exhibition. If they are not at the 26th Australian Turfgrass Conference Trade Exhibition they will be contacted by phone or email. Winners will also be announced in the AGCSA's weekly email newsletter The Cut.

## **7. PRIZE COLLECTION**

**7.1.** Prizes can be collected immediately following announcement of the winners from the AGCSA stand located within the 26th Australian Turfgrass Conference Trade Exhibition at the Gold Coast Convention and Exhibition Centre. Those winners not in attendance at the time of being announced will be contacted and arrangements made to courier the prize to them.

**7.2.** When winners are notified, they may be asked to verify their current employment status within the turf management profession. The Promoter reserves the right to request winners provide proof of identity and/or proof of employment in order to claim a prize. Proof of identity, employment and/or entry validity considered suitable for verification is at the Promoter's discretion. In the event that a winner cannot provide suitable proof, the winner will forfeit the prize in whole and no substitute will be offered.

## **8. PRIZE AVAILABILITY**

The Promoter will not be responsible or liable if for any reason beyond their reasonable control any element of any prize is not provided. The Promoter may, subject to State regulations, substitute a different prize of equivalent value in place of any prize referred to in these terms and conditions.

## **9. TAXES**

Any tax payable as a result of a prize being awarded or received will be the responsibility of the winner. Winners should seek independent financial advice prior to accepting a prize if this is a concern.

## **10. UNCLAIMED PRIZES**

Prizes unclaimed after a period of three months will be forfeited and at 10am on Friday 24 September a redraw will occur at the Australian Golf Course Superintendents Association Head Office, 1/752 Blackburn Rd, Clayton, VIC 3168 and the name drawn will receive the prize.

## **11. RELEASE AND INDEMNITY**

To the extent permitted by law, all entrants release from, and indemnify the Promoter against all liability, cost, loss or expense arising out of acceptance of any prize(s) or participation in the Competition including (but not limited to) loss of income, loss of opportunity, personal injury and damage to property, whether direct or consequential, foreseeable, due to some negligent act or omission or otherwise.

## **12. TAMPERING AND OTHER MATTERS**

**12.1.** If for any reason this Competition is not capable of running as planned as a result of any (including but not limited to) technical failures, unauthorised intervention, tampering, fraud or any other causes beyond the control of the Promoter which corrupts or affects the administration, security, fairness, integrity or proper conduct of this Competition, the Promoter reserves the right (subject to State regulations) to disqualify any individual who (whether directly or indirectly) causes the same and/or to cancel, terminate, modify or suspend the Competition.

**12.2.** The Promoter accepts no responsibility for any late, lost or misdirected entries.

### **13. EXCLUSION OF PARTICIPANTS**

The Promoter reserves the right to exclude any person from participating in the Competition or a prize for any reason.

### **14. TERMINATION OF COMPETITION**

The Promoter may (subject to State Regulations), vary the terms of or terminate this Competition at any time at its absolute discretion without liability to any contestant or other person. The Promoter will not award the prize if the Competition is terminated.

### **15. DECISIONS FINAL**

All decisions and actions of the Promoter relating to the Competition and/or redemption of the prizes are exercised according to its absolute discretion and are final. No discussions or correspondence with entrants or any other person will be entered into.

### **16. FAILURE TO ENFORCE TERMS AND CONDITIONS**

A failure by the Promoter to enforce any one of these terms and conditions in any instance(s) will not give rise to any claim or right of action by any other person or contestant.
