Professional Presentations	<p>Presenting to superintendents/turf managers at the Australian Turfgrass Conference or other national associations conference including the preparation of accompanying material;</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Presenting to superintendents/turf managers at either state/regional seminars, online or electronically including the preparation of accompanying material. 	<p>Presentations at a national level attract 4 CEP</p> <p>Presentations at either a regional/state event or an online/electronic workshop attracts 2 CEP</p>

Study Tours	<p>This allows members who participate in either national or international study tours relating to turf management to gain additional points.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Programmes eligibility would be determined by the education committee upon application. Teaching	<p>This allows for AGCSA members to gain points as a result of delivering a course to turf professionals through recognised educational facilities.</p>	<p>2 hours instruction equals 1 CEP.</p> <p>Max 10 per renewal period.</p>
Volunteer / Social Work	<p>This allows members who give their free time to volunteer or support community recognised social programmes outside of their work/family circles to gain additional points.</p> <p>Programme's eligibility would be determined by the education committee upon application.</p>	Up to 5 CEP can be awarded over a renewal period.
Wages/Water/ Best Practice Surveys	<p>This would involve completion of AGCSA surveys circulated at various intervals.</p>	Completion of a survey equals 1 CEP
Workshops	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Workshops/seminars offered by a national superintendents association (AGCSA, GCSAA, BIGGA, etc.) would be automatically approved for points; Workshops/seminars run by state associations or trade hosted day would require certification by the education committee 	<p>2 hour of instruction equals 2 CEP</p> <p>State/regional conference awarded CEP on educational content.</p> <p>Proof of attendance to be submitted for non AGCSA hosted events.</p>
